



## **Environmental policy for Hedlunds Timber AB**

The company is a sawmill situated in **Furudal**. We process the renewable Swedish forest to high quality timber. It's activities are adapted to the traceability requirements of the international well-known certificationsystems. The company aim to minimize the negative environmental effects on the Swedish forest.

### **We will achive this by;**

- Work to ensure that forestry is sustainable and environmentally friendly.
  - The company shall comply with exsisting national/international rules.
  - The company does not accept wood from following sources:
    - \* illegal harvesting
    - \* Forests with high conservation values\*
    - \* Forests where traditional or civil rights are violated
    - \* Forests of genetically engineered trees
    - \* Natural forests that have been harvested for the purpose of land to plantations or non-forest use
- \* In Sweden, defined as key habitats according to the Forestry Board's definition and methodology. Exceptions apply felling within key habitats in order to strengthen natural values, used in accordance with the Forestry Authority's recommendation .
- Our environmental work is characterized by a holistic approach and conducted with the goal to achieve continuous improvement through positive skills development in the organization.
  - The key personnel in the company that affect the traceability certificate shall be given the knowledge of environmental management and the environmental impact of its operations. All employees must be familiar with company policies and feel part of the company's traceability/certification work.
